


We use 'did' for a past simple action (that is complete).

The negative form is: did not (didn't).

**NOTE TO REMEMBER:

In the past simple, the negative of <u>has</u> changes to <u>have</u> even for He/She/It.

This is because <u>have</u> is the infinitive.




