An example of communications from other planets was in 1896 when a newspaper article entitled "A Signal from Mars. In 1901, engineer Nicola Tesla made the astonishing claim that he was receiving radio communications from Mars. The Media was captured by his idea but it did not find much serious interest from scientists. In the 1960s a number of other scientists began searching for signals showing the existence of another life elsewhere in the universe.
