The human body is a wonderful machine which performs several functions without rest from birth. Our body continues to work, without stopping for a second. The main organs of the human body are lungs, heart, kidney, liver and brain. These organs work together and are controlled by the brain. Each system such as digestive system, excretory system, circulatory system, endocrine system, nervous system or muscular system carries out a major function. All of them are controlled by the brain which gives us intelligence to use our physical and mental abilities. The body has more than 50,000 living cells of two hundred different types. These cells include neurons (nerve cells) and glands (specialized cells). The hormones and enzymes are produced and secreted by these glandethat perform different functions. The human body is covered by the skin, which is a flexible covering the protects the body and keeps water and harmful germs out. The body's strong internal framework (skeleton) is made of 206 bones, connected at the joint, such as in legs. These joints help us to move. The sections supports the head and limbs and protects the spinal cord. Between the skeleton and the skin, there are yout 500 muscles. Nerves spread from the brain to all parts of the body, carrying signals in the local of tiny electrical impulses. The sense organs namely eyes, nose, ears, tongue and skin pass the message to the brain through nerves. They take the instructions from the brain to the muscles. The brain automatical scontrols breathing, heartbeat, direction, etc.
