

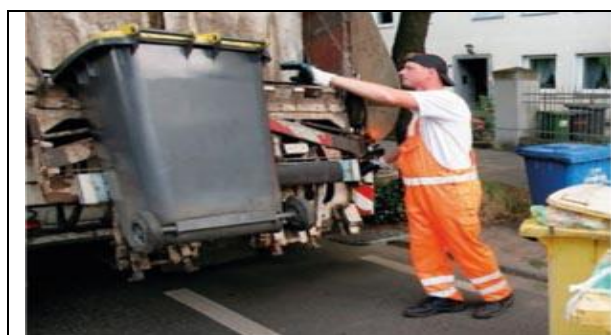

How can people prevent water-related illnesses?	By having better sewage system and water purification.

What was your experience with "dirt" as a child? Were you allowed to play outside a lot?	Yes, I was allowed to play outside a lot. I didn't think about dirt.
What vaccinations do children and adults usually get now? What vaccinations did you get as a child?	Measles, hepatitis, chicken pox, etc.
