Houses Around the World

There are some very unusual houses around the world. One example is the igloo. An igloo is an interesting home in cold and snowy places like Alaska, Canada, and Siberia *Igloo* means *house* in a language called Inuit. An igloo is a snow house. People build blocks¹ from snow. Then they use the blocks to make a dome. A dome is the shape of half of a circle. Inside the igloo, there is one large room. Usually one or two families share the igloo. It is warm inside. There is a cooking area, a sleeping area, a living area, and one door to go outside.

Another kind of home is a houseboat—a house on a boat. People enjoy living on houseboats in many parts of the world. Modern houseboats come in many sizes and styles.
