1 Many studies of human behavior show that people around us greatly influence our choices and decisions. This is called "social proof". Psychologists say that when we are not sure what to do, we look at what others are doing. The actions of other people are the "proof" of the right thing to do.

2 Businesses are very interested in understanding social proof. This is because they want to influence us to buy their products. For that reason, social proof is very important in advertising. Four groups of people give social proof: experts, other consumers, crowds, and friends. First, experts often influence our actions and purchases. For example, an expert on a TV health show may recommend a medicine. Because experts know a lot about their fields and are **conversant**, we may follow their advice. 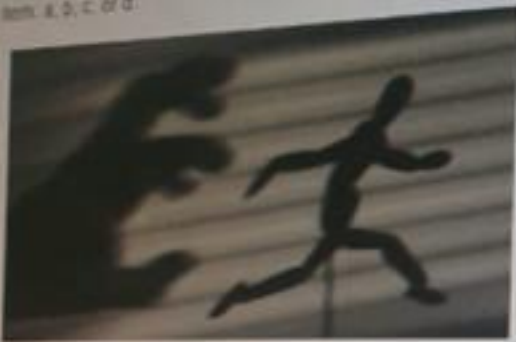
