<b>accountant</b>	a person whose job is to keep and examine records of money received or paid out by a business	<b>contable</b>

<b>affair</b>	a sexual relationship, usually secret, between two people who are not married to one another	<b>aventura (amorosa)</b>
<b>Asian (n or adj)</b>	a person from one of the countries in Asia (e.g. Indian or Pakistan)	<b>asiático</b>
<b>bikini</b>	a woman's two-piece swim-suit	<b>bikini</b>
<b>blonde (adj)</b>	golden- or yellow-haired	<b>rubio/a</b>
<b>bloody (adj)</b>	a swearword used to emphasize an angry statement or an order	<b>maldito/a</b>
<b>blue moon</b>	from the expression "once in a blue moon", meaning very rarely or never	<b>de Pascuas a Ramos</b>
<b>bush</b>	a large flowering plant, e.g. a rosebush	<b>arbusto, mata</b>
<b>cadet</b>	a young person who is training to become a police officer	<b>cadete</b>
<b>ceramics</b>	objects made of porcelain or china, e.g. sinks, toilets, etc.	<b>cerámica</b>
<b>chairman</b>	the chief official in a company or other organization	<b>presidente (de una empresa, etc.)</b>
<b>charity</b>	an organization which exists to help people in need	<b>organización benéfica</b>
<b>conference</b>	a meeting, especially a large one, for discussion or exchange of ideas	<b>conferencia</b>
