**cuisine** /kwɪ'zi:n/ (noun): The **cuisine** of a country is its typical style of cooking.  
**dish** (noun): food prepared in a particular way. A **dish** is also a type of plate.  
**dumpling** (noun): round ball made with flour and cooked in water  
**filling** (noun): The **filling** is the part in the middle of food like a sandwich, a cake, etc.  
**recipe** /'resɪpi:/ (noun): the instructions for making a particular dish  
**spices** (plural noun): A **spice** is a powder made from part of a plant, e.g. pepper, chilli.  
**vegetarian** (noun and adjective): A **vegetarian** is a person who doesn't eat meat.
