Directions to the Assessor:

- Ask each student 1 set of 5 questions. Assess the questions according to the Mid Module Speaking Exam rating scale. Please note that the scale asks you to provide one score for Questions 1-2 (combined) and one score for question 3-5 (combined). **You do not record scores for each individual question.** There is also a pronunciation score for the whole assessment. Record the marks on the sheet provided.
- For each question, ask the main question first and then after the student replies, ask any listed follow up questions (such as "Why/Why not?", "When?", etc.).
- Questions 1 and 2 expect a medium length response of 3-4 sentences in order to receive full marks. Questions 3 and 4 need to be fully answered to get full marks. Question 5 expects a long response of a paragraph or more in order to receive full marks.

SET A.

3. Give at least 3 pieces of advice for someone who is not getting on with a teacher or classmate.
4. Choose a website that you like and tell me 3 advantages of using it.
5. Is it important for children to take part in competitions where they can win or lose? Give at least 3 reasons why or why not.

1. Do you think you are good at giving advice? Why or why not?
2. Which objects would you like to own in the future? Why?
3. Give at least 3 pieces of advice telling someone how they can stay calm in difficult situations.
4. Give at least 2 advantages and 2 disadvantages of working (having a job)?
5. Would you prefer to have your own business or to be an employee in a company? Give at least 3 reasons for your answer.
