Through innovation and c-government, governments around the world can be more efficient as they provide better services and respond to the demands of their citizens by transparency and liability. They can be more comprehensive and restore the trust of citizens in their governments.

E-government services have three classifications. Firstly, Government-to-Government (G2G) involves sharing data and conducting electronic exchanges between governmental sectors, as well as exchanges between the national, regional, and local levels. Secondly, Government-to-Business (G2B) includes business-specific transactions (e.g. payments, sale and purchase of goods and services) as well as delivery online of business-focused services. Finally, Government-to-Consumer (G2C) comprises initiatives to simplify people's interaction with the government as consumers of public services and contribute to the consultation and decision-making process.
