- توضع العلامة المستحقّة لكلّ سؤال إلى يسار الرقم على ورقة الإجابة باللغة العربيّة.
- توضع إشارة (X) على رقم الإجابة الخطأ.
- تجمع درجات الإجابة لكلّ مجموعة وتوضع في مربع عند نهاية المجموعة في الزاوية اليمنى وتكتب رقماً وكتابة باللغة العربيّة.
- ترفع درجات كلّ مجموعة إلى الحقل المخصّص لها في جدول الدرجات ويوقع عليها كلّ من المصحّح والمدقّق مع مراعاة حقول الآحاد والعشرات والمئات.
- عند نهاية تصحيح موضوع الإنشاء يوضع حرف S للأخطاء الإملائية، وحرف P لأخطاء علامات الترقيم، وحرف V لأخطاء المفردات، وحرف G للأخطاء القواعدية، وحرف T (Task Response) أي المضمون، لسهولة التصحيح، وتوضع الدرجة المستحقّة بجانب كلّ حرف، ثمّ تجمع الدرجات وتكتب ضمن مربع (رقماً وكتابة) في أسفل الموضوع، وترفع إلى الحقل المخصّص لها في جدول الدرجات.

## Group1 From 1- 10

### Model answers: (1-3)

- 1- c / teach
- 2- a / Experienced
- 3- b / to attract the listeners' attention

### Remarks from (1-3)

- 1- Each correct answer is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- Only the above mentioned answers are accepted.
- 3- Both the letter corresponding to the correct answer and the correct choice are accepted, or one of them.
- 4- If the student writes two letters or two choices for the same number, consider the first.
- 5- Overlook copying mistakes in case the student writes the answer in words .

### Model answers from (4-5)

- 4- incredibly
- 5- remember

### Remarks from (4-5)

- 1- Each item is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- Only the above mentioned answers are accepted.
- 3- Overlook copying mistakes and capitalization.
- 4- If the student writes two answers for the same number, consider the first.

### **Model answers from (6-8)**

6- false

7- false

8- true

### **Remarks from (6-8)**

- 1- Each correct answer is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- Only the above mentioned answers are accepted.
- 3- If the student writes both "true" and "false" for the same number, consider the first.
- 4- Any sign or word that denotes true or false is accepted, e.g. (X / √) (صح أو خطأ)

### **Model answers from (9-10)**

9- Before the surgery, surgical nurses make sure that the patient is in a stable condition and healthy enough to have the operation and they explain to him what is going to happen during it.

**(N.B):** One item is allotted **full mark**.

10- (Surgical nurses change the patients' bandages) after the operation / surgery.

### **Remarks from (9-10)**

- 1- Each item is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- Any logical answer is accepted.
- 3- Overlook irrelevant information providing that the addition should not exceed two sentences. If so, deduct **5 marks**.
- 4- Overlook copying and grammar mistakes.

**(N.B):** Information between brackets is optional.

## Group 2 From 11-25

### Model answers (11-14)

11- make

12- too much

13- isn't

14- yet

### Remarks from (11-14)

- 1- Each item is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- Only the above mentioned answers are accepted.
- 3- If the student writes two answers in one space, consider the first.
- 4- Overlook capitalization and copying mistakes.

### Model answers (15-18)

15- c / Have

16- a / when

17- a / How long

18- c / an

### Remarks from (15-18)

- 1- Each item is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- Only the above mentioned answers are accepted.
- 3- Both the letter corresponding to the correct answer and the correct choice are accepted, or one of them.
- 4- If the student writes two answers for one space, consider the first.
- 5- Overlook capitalization and copying mistakes.

### **Model answers (19-21)**

19- were / got

20- who

21- my

**(N.B) 19-:** If the student writes (are – was – is – get) his answer rates **5 marks**.

**(N.B) 21-:** If the student writes (the – his – your – her) his answer rates **5 marks**.

### **Remarks from (19-21)**

- 1- Each item is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- Only the above mentioned answers are accepted.
- 3- If the student writes two answers in one space, consider the first.
- 4- Overlook capitalization and spelling mistakes unless it gives rise to another word.

### **Model answers (22-25)**

22- c / because the weather was bad.

23- d / you will miss the bus.

24- b / he can't concentrate in the class.

25- e / He is a journalist.

### **Remarks from (22-25)**

- 1- Each item is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- Only the above mentioned answers are accepted.
- 3- Both the letter corresponding to the correct answer and the correct choice are accepted, or one of them.
- 4- If the student writes two answers in one space, consider the first.
- 5- Overlook capitalization and copying mistakes.
- 6- If the student matches the two parts using arrows clearly, his answer is accepted.
- 7- Any omission after the first word in the correct choice is overlooked.

## Group 3 From 26-35

### Model answers (26-30)

- 26- was having
- 27- won
- 28- will be
- 29- has been studying
- 30- had left

### Remarks from (26-30)

- 1- Each item is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- Only the above mentioned answers are accepted.
- 3- If the student writes only the first word of the correct answer, it rates full mark.
- 4- If the student writes two answers for the same number, consider the first.
- 5- Overlook copying mistakes.

### Model answers (31-35)

- 31- Where have you been?
  - What / Which place have you been to?
  - Have you been to Souk AlHamedya or (any other place **e.g.** Al-Hamra street)?
- 32- Who(m) did you go with?
  - With whom did you go?
  - Who went with you?
- 33- What did she want to buy?
  - Why did she go (there / to Souk AlHamedya)?
  - What did she buy?
  - What did she want to do?
  - Why were you there?
- 34- **(Answers vary)**
- 35- **(Answers vary)**

### Remarks from (31-35)

- 1- Each item is allotted **10 marks**.
- 2- The above mentioned answers are accepted in addition to:
  - \* Any logical question that is related to the answer from 31-33 is accepted.
  - \* Any logical answer that is related to the question from 34-35 is accepted.
- 3- Overlook capitalization, punctuation and spelling mistakes.
- 4- If the student writes the correct question word only, his answer is allotted **4 marks**.
- 5- Deduct **2 marks** for each grammatical mistake providing that the total deduction shouldn't exceed **4 marks** if the sentence still makes sense.

## Group 4 - Composition

### Remarks:

- 1- **(50 marks)** are allotted to this item.
- 2- Before starting the correction of the composition, the teacher should make first reading to the whole paragraph to figure out if it is relevant to the topic or not.
  - a- A paragraph between 40 – 50 words rates **fifty marks**.
  - b- A paragraph between 30 – 39 words, start correcting with **forty marks**.
    - Deduct two marks from each category .
  - c- A paragraph between 25 – 29 words, start correcting with **thirty marks**.
    - Deduct four marks from each category .
  - d- A paragraph between 15 – 24 words , start correcting with **twenty marks**.
    - Deduct six marks from each category .
  - e- A paragraph less than 15 words rates **fifteen marks**.
  - f- If the student writes two compositions , correct the first one .
  - g- Overlook the first 2 mistakes in spelling.
  - h- Overlook the first 2 mistakes in grammar .
  - i- Deduct one mark for each spelling mistake.
  - j- Deduct one mark for each grammar mistake.
  - k- Deduct **once** for the same repeated mistake.
- 3- The following chart shows the distribution of the **(50 marks)**:
