The transmitter has two joysticks. One is on the left. This is the left-hand (LH) stick. The other is on the right. This is the right-hand (RH) stick. Look at the LH joystick. This controls the speed and direction of the plane. Push the LH stick up (away from you) and the plane accelerates. Pull **it** down (towards you) and the plane slows down. Slide the stick to the left and plane turns left. Slide it to the right and it turns right. Now look at the RH joystick. **This** controls the roll and the tilt of the plane. Push the RH stick up (away from you) and the plane descends (goes down). Pull it down (towards you) and the plane ascends (goes up). Slide the stick to the left and the plane rolls to the left. Slide it to the right and it rolls to the right.
