NOTICE OF COMPETITION FOR THE AWARD OF EIGHT EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS REGISTERED FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF A MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAM AT LUISS GUIDO CARLI

2020/2021 Academic Year

Luiss Guido Carli offers 8 excellence scholarships to students registered for the first year of a master's degree program in the 2020-2021 academic year who have a currently valid GMAT or GRE score.

The scholarships consist of a full waiver of the University's annual tuition fee for the entire standard duration of the degree program.

1. Awarding of the aid

This competition is open to students who, as at the date of the deadline for submission of applications for this competition, hold GMAT certification with a minimum score of 710 or equivalent GRE certification (converted on the basis of the annexed table) and have passed all of the exams provided for in their undergraduate study plan, with the exception of the final degree exam in the case of students still in the process of graduating.

The scholarships will be formulated on the basis of GMAT or GRE scores, in decreasing order, and allocated in accordance with the following criterion:

- 2 scholarships for the Department of Political Science;
- 2 scholarships for the Department of Business and Management;
- 2 scholarships for the Department of Economics and Finance;
- 2 scholarships for the Department of Law.

In the case of a tie, preference will be accorded to the student with the highest bachelor's degree weighted average.

Should the student come from a non-Italian university, the credits and grades will be compared with those awarded in the Italian university system: for this purpose the application form must be accompanied by a Transcript of Records indicating the Grade Point Average (GPA) and a document explaining the grading system of the student's university/country. All attachments must be in English or Italian, failing which the student will be excluded from the competition.

Unallocated scholarships, if any, will be redistributed among the other Departments in proportion to the number of applications out of the total.

The awarding of the scholarships will be communicated by July 2020.

2. Incompatibility

The aid envisaged by this competition is incompatible with other tuition fee waivers or scholarships held for any reason whatsoever, except for those awarded by Italian or foreign institutions designed to support, through periods abroad, a student's education for the academic years covered by this competition.

3. Renewal of the aid

The scholarship will be renewed for the entire standard duration of the degree program year on condition that the student, by the end of the summer exam session of the first year, has earned at least 70% of the education credits required under their study plan for graduation and also has a weighted grade average of not less than 27/30.

4. Revocation

The aid envisaged by this competition will be revoked upon the occurrence of any one of the following:

- a. the student fails to enroll at LUISS Guido Carli for the first year of a master's degree program for the 2020/2021 academic year;
- b. the student no longer fulfills the merit requirements necessary for renewal for the second year, as specified in the preceding article;
- c. the student discontinues their studies;
- d. the student transfers to another university.

5. Submission of applications

Applications to participate in this competition can be submitted, using the online form available at the Financial Aid and Scholarships web pages, from 15 May 2020 to noon on 3 July 2020.

The application form must be accompanied by the following documentation:

- for students coming from another Italian university: self-certification/official certification of the exams taken with associated grade. Students must also record on the form all the exams that they have taken with the associated grades and credits in order to be able to display during the application process the weighted average to which priority will be accorded in the case of a tie;
- for students coming from another university abroad: Transcript of Records and document explaining the grading system;
- GMAT or GRE certification.





Only complete applications received by the deadline of 3 July 2020 will be considered. LUISS Guido Carli disclaims any liability in relation to applications that are not received due to technical issues or reasons attributable to third parties.
