The atmosphere contains oxygen and other gases that living things need to live. In turn, living things with **atoms** and molecules of gases move around the **globe** and in and out of living things, the land and the water.

Living things also need warmth and liquid water. By trapping energy from the sun, the atmosphere keeps most of Earth's surface warm enough for water to exist as a liquid. In addition, Earth's atmosphere protects living things from the sun's dangerous radiation.
