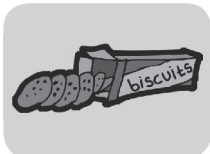

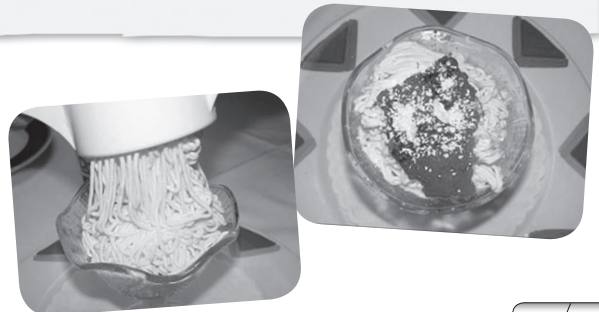
ICE CREAM FUN!
