+ Affirmative

SUBJECT
I / you / we / they
he / she / it

VERB
+ lived ...

+ Affirmative: I **lived** in London.
+ Affirmative: She **lived** in Paris.
+ Affirmative: He **watched** a movie.
+ Affirmative: They **wanted** a holiday.

Past tense regular verbs end in **-ed**.
There is only one form of each verb in the past simple tense.*

* The exception is **TO BE** which has two forms: was and were.

* The base form of the infinitive = to go, to need, to speak, to live
The verb is not in the past tense in negative sentences. "Didn't" tells us it is a past tense sentence.

+ Affirmative: I **lived** in Spain.
- Negative: I **didn't live** in Spain.

+ Affirmative: He **watched** a movie.
- Negative: He **didn't watch** a movie.

The verb is not in the past tense in questions. "Did" tells us we are asking a past tense question.

+ Affirmative: You **lived** in Italy.
? Question: **Did** you **live** in Italy?

+ Affirmative: She **watched** a movie.
? Question: **Did** she **watch** a movie?

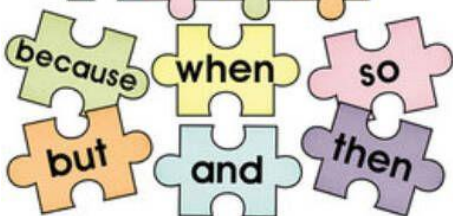

Conjunctions

A conjunction is a joining word. We use conjunctions to join two words, phrases or clauses together to make one long sentence.

(but) I go swimming but I didn't play tennis on Sunday .

تستخدم لتبين الزمن. (عندما) كنت في الحديقته عندما بدأت تمطر . (when) I was at the park when it's started raining .

تستخدم لتبين السبب وتكون جمله السبب الثانيه (لان) هو يشعر بالبرد لانه نسي ارتداء المعطف .

(because) he feels cold because he forget to wear his jacket .

تستخدم لتبين السبب وتكون جمله السبب الاولى (لذا) هو نسي ارتداء المعطف لذا يشعر بالبرد .

(so) he forget to wear his jacket so he feels cold .

Gerund vs Infinitive in English

	Gerund	Infinitive
What are Gerunds and Infinitives?	A gerund is a verb which ends in "-ing" and is used as a noun. <ul style="list-style-type: none">the gerund "running"	An infinitive is a verb which is preceded by "to" and is used as a verb. <ul style="list-style-type: none">the infinitive "to run"
Difference	1. We use a gerund as a noun, while an infinitive is used as a verb. <ul style="list-style-type: none">the gerund "running" can be used as a noun, while the infinitive "to run" is used as a verb. 2. Other differences include how they are used in a sentence and how they are formed.	
Examples	<ul style="list-style-type: none">She loves swimming. (Gerund)I like reading books. (Gerund)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">I need to go shopping. (Infinitive)He helped me (to) understand the lesson. (Infinitive)
