A bird's territory may be small of large. Some males protect only their nest and the area right around it, while others such as hawks, protect wider territories which include their hunting areas. Gulls, penguins, and other waterfowls nest in huge colonies, but even in the biggest colonies, each male and his mate have tiny territories of their own immediately around their nest. Males defend their territories chiefly against other males of the same species. In some cases, a warning call or a threatening pose may be the only defence that is needed, but in other cases, intruders may refuse to leave peacefully and a battle for the territory takes place.
