- 1. Children who immigrate to the United States do better than children who are born there. When they grow up, their own children also do better. Many children from Asia do really well in everything. However, it does not mean that <u>immigrant</u> children always do better. Some immigrants will have several advantages over American youths.
- 2. Sociologist Lingxin Hao said that children of immigrants succeed because they have higher hopes. They work harder to reach their goals and they have better cultural tools. They have the experience of living their first years in another country. This helps them to be successful adults.

- 3. The study shows that immigrants succeed because their parents want them to work harder. They also have a stronger relationship with their teachers. <u>In most countries</u>, people respect teachers. Teachers respond to students who <u>study</u> harder and show respect. That creates a strong relationship between the teacher and the student.
- 4. Hao said that family <u>support</u> is the main reason why immigrant children do better than their peers. The parents have a positive idea about bringing up their children in the United States. People immigrate to improve their children's lives. They believe that the United States is the land of <u>opportunity</u> and that their hard <u>work</u> will result in success.
